

Vice-Chancellor's International High Achiever's Scholarship

CDU offers a limited number of 50% and 25% tuition fee scholarships for international students who have a record of academic excellence and high achievement. The tuition scholarships apply to the tuition fees for the full duration of an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree. The scholarships are awarded on demonstrated academic merit and are available to students seeking to commence a degree at CDU in semester 2, 2017.

Eligibility for Scholarship

- A demonstrated record of academic excellence and high achievement in previous relevant studies and qualifications;
- Must meet the University's academic and English entry requirement;
- Must have applied and obtained an offer (GTE cleared) to a degree at CDU for semester 2, 2017;
- Must not hold any other scholarship from an Australian or foreign sponsoring agency;
- Must have submitted a completed application for the scholarship by 1 May 2017 for commencement in semester 2, 2017;
- Applicants must **not** hold current Australian Citizenship, Australian Permanent Resident or a New Zealand Citizenship.

Obligations for Scholarship

- Student must enrol as a full-time on campus student and commence studies in semester 2, 2017
- Student must maintain satisfactory academic progress each semester – that is, a Credit average or better (65 – 75%) and with no fail grade in any subject;
- The tuition fee scholarship will be applied directly upon enrolment each semester;
- Students must pay the remaining balance of their tuition on or before the start of each semester;
- The scholarship is neither transferrable for cash, nor refundable and cannot be transferred to another person, semester, course or year;
- Students must abide by the CDU (Student of the University) by-laws;
- Students must be paying international tuition fees and not domestic fees;
- Students are required to inform the International Office via email international@cdu.edu.au of any visa status changes immediately as this may result in a termination of the scholarship.

The VCIHAS scholarships are very competitive and meeting the minimum eligibility standards described above does not guarantee that you will be awarded a scholarship.

All applicants who meet the minimum eligibility standards will be included in the selection process. The decision of the University selection panel is final.
