

Engineering Diversity Scholarship Program

Territory Generation and Engineers Australia have partnered to provide a \$3,000 scholarship program to foster diversity in the engineering sector.

One scholarship, worth a total of \$3,000, will be offered in 2023 over two semesters.

The scholarship may be awarded to an eligible:

- Indigenous Australian student (male or female); or
- a female student

enrolled in a Bachelor (or Masters) of Engineering at Charles Darwin University.

Scholarship recipients will also be given the opportunity to undertake valuable paid work placements with Territory Generation during semester breaks in 2023.

Purpose:

- To foster diversity in the Northern Territory's engineering sector
- To provide financial support and industry experience to a student considering a career in the engineering sector

Benefits:

- Split payment of \$3,000 (\$1,500 upon successful completion of semesters 1 and 2)
- Opportunity to undertake paid work placement with Territory Generation during university holidays or mutually agreed suitable periods

Applications open: 20 March 2023

Applications close: 9 May 2023

Eligibility Criteria:**Must be:**

- Indigenous and/or female
- Enrolled in a Bachelor [or Masters] of Engineering at Charles Darwin University
- A resident of the Northern Territory
- Enrolled full-time or part-time for the duration of the scholarship and commit to undertaking the work placement/s within one year from the award of the scholarship. If a part-time student, they must have completed at minimum the equivalent of 50% of their degree
- An Australian citizen or holder of an Australian permanent resident visa or permanent humanitarian visa

How to apply:

Please email the following items to nt@engineersaustralia.org.au:

- A CV (maximum 2 pages) including any work history or unpaid work experience, education and /or training, awards and certificates, volunteer experience, and the contact details of two referees
- A 400-word statement outlining why you want to be an engineer and how the scholarship will help you to achieve that goal
- Confirmation of CDU Engineering enrolment [course/full-time/part-time]
- Confirmation of Northern Territory Residency
- Confirmation of Indigeneity if relevant
